KIDS INITIATIVE (KI) BOOT ROOM LAUNCHES

The most ambitious project under our KI scheme has got underway and is off to a flying start.

The idea is to engage with schools and sports clubs appealing for pre-loved and unwanted football boots and trainers to be donated so that we can redistribute them to kids who do not have any and are therefore unable to take part in school sports.

Within the first couple of weeks we have collected close to 100 pairs of varying sports shoes & boots, the majority in very good condition.

In addition to the recycled shoes we collect we will also be supplying new boots and trainers in the sizes we do not have sufficient numbers of.

We also intend to donate to schools other equipment such as shin pads and goal keeping gloves.
